

Community of Diebougou

The community of Diebougou is situated in South-West Burkina in the Bougouriba province amidst an interethnic and interreligious population.

The community numbers six temporary and finally professed sisters, 30 to 70 years of age, from four nationalities. Marked by our personal histories, our cultures, the history of our countries, of our Churches, we strive to come to better know the people among whom we are inserted as well as one another, to “widen the space of our tent” (Is.54:2) and live out our differences to the utmost. **What we want is to root ourselves evermore in Christ Jesus and to allow ourselves to be led by the Spirit. He is the One who prompts us to build a House of Charity.** He is the One who sends us to serve his people through our respective ministries and live out “His mission of Love”.

Our main activity is the Center for Recovery and Nutritional Education (CREN) dedicated to malnourished children. We are also in charge of Marie Balavenne Hostel for young students; we teach or study in the middle and secondary school run by Christian Brothers, we nurse at the hospital of Diebougou; we play our part in the parish Council, in the teaching of catechesis, we take part in the Justice-Peace-Integrity of Creation committee, in the accompaniment of young sisters.
